Deposit: \$1,000, credited to the camp fee, is to be submitted with each application. The balance of the camp fee is due in full by **May 1, 2020**. The entire deposit is refundable through **Dec. 1, 2019**; one half of the deposit is refundable through **May 1, 2020**.

The camp fee includes health care, weekly laundry service, most trips out of camp, and most materials used in instructional program. Leaving camp due to physical illness or accident will result in a refund of one-half of the remaining fee. **No** refunds will be given for leaving camp due to homesickness. Medical expenses resulting from doctor or hospital visits are the responsibility of parents.

THERE ARE NO REDUCTIONS FOR LATE ARRIVAL FOR A SESSION OR EARLY DEPARTURE FROM A SESSION.

Discount: A sibling discount of 5% will be made for two or more campers from the same family enrolled for **four or more** weeks at Camps Netimus or Shohola.

- Items charged to spending allowance may include canteen, camp store, waterskiing, some program materials, doctor visits, prescriptions, expenses and spending money for trips.
- Any unused amount will be refunded to parents at the end of the camp season. (*You may donate your remaining balance to NTAP, Netimus Tuition Assistance Program; please check the appropriate box on page 2 of the application form.*)
- Any overdraw will be billed to parents.
- All cash must be turned into the office upon arrival. Camp Netimus is not responsible for any cash kept by the camper.

Equestrian: Participation in the program is at a total additional cost per session of:

Season (7), (5) weeks or (4) weeks:	6 days per week: \$700 OR 3 days per week: \$500
(3) Weeks or June 28 (2) weeks:	6 days per week: \$500 OR 3 days per week: \$300
July 12 (2) weeks:	6 days per week: \$400 OR 3 days per week: \$250

Campers are encouraged to participate in the maximum number of lessons; fees cannot be refunded because of weather, optional out-of-camp-trips and all-day events that reduce the number of lessons attended.

Tutoring: By special arrangement with the Director, academic tutoring is available (\$30.00/hour).

Transportation: Transportation to and from camp by chartered bus or camp van from New York City, Philadelphia, Baltimore and Washington, DC for an additional cost of \$100 (one-way) or \$200 (roundtrip). Specifics available online: "Parents", "Forms and Additional Info", click on "Transportation Form".

Visiting: Parents of Season or Five Week campers may visit during the weekend of **July 25 - 26**. Visits to other campers are limited to the first or last day of the session in which the camper is enrolled. There are no exceptions to this policy.

ADDITIONAL OPTIONS FOR INTERNATIONAL CAMPERS:

Linen and trunk rental: International campers may rent blankets, sheets, a pillow, towels and a trunk in which to store clothing (\$85 for 5 to 7 weeks; \$60 for 2, 3 and 4 weeks).

Transport to/from airports: Transportation with a senior staff member to/from Camp Netimus for Newark airport costs \$200 (roundtrip), \$100 (one-way) and JFK airport costs \$500 (roundtrip), \$250 (one-way). **IMPORTANT:** Contact camp with flight details **before** finalizing travel plans.

International Insurance: All international campers must be covered by Camp Netimus' Accident & Sickness Insurance Policy (\$40.00 for 2, 3 and 4 week sessions; \$60.00 for 5 week and season sessions).
